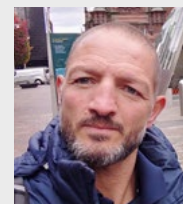

ARRIVAL AND REGISTRATION

Access to the Stadium will be through the **East Stand entrance** on Worcester Avenue, with registration and refreshments in the Lower East Side sports bar. The seminars will take place in the Stadium Briefing room, with delegates being given directions to the Stadium Briefing Room at registration.

HOW TO FIND THE EVENT

Tottenham Hotspur Stadium is highly accessible by public transport.

BY TRAIN

The Stadium is served by four train stations:

1. White Hart Lane (London Overground): approx. 10 mins walk to Stadium East Entrance
2. Northumberland Park (Abellio Greater Anglia Services): 10 mins walk to Stadium East Entrance
3. Tottenham Hale (London Underground Victoria Line and Abellio Greater Anglia Services): 25 mins walk to Stadium East Entrance
4. Seven Sisters (London Underground Victoria Line and London Overground): 30 mins walk to Stadium East Entrance

BY BUS

The Stadium is well-served by TFL buses, which run up and down the High Road (including bus numbers 149, 259, 279 and 349), as well as along White Hart Lane (W3).

BY BIKE

There are a number of on-street and off-street cycle parking spaces around the Stadium.

BY CAR

There are very limited paid parking opportunities within walking distance of the stadium.

POST-EVENT NETWORKING

For delegates who would like to extend their networking, we recommend continuing your discussions over a drink at the **Beavertown Corner Pin pub** after the formal close of the event at 4.30pm. The pub is located on the corner of Park Lane and the High Road – opposite the exit to the Tottenham Experience.
